**NOTICE:** Nominations for the officers and directors of Diablo Rod and Gun Club will be held at the next meeting.

**AIR GUN:** This year's Airgun League is underway. Shoots are held on the **second** and **fourth Friday Nights** each month through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so <u>some shooting experience is required</u>. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for shooters who don't have their own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. There are three matches left. Sign-up starts at 6:30 PM and shooting starts at 7:00 PM. This is our 28<sup>th</sup> consecutive year. FFI: Pam Rogers (831-1037) or Ilene Falkenstein (687-5491).

**DIABLO SOCIAL:** The next Social will be on Tuesday, April 19<sup>th</sup>. The Club will provide the finger foods and drinks, including sodas, beer, wine, and spirits. **RIFLE AND PISTOL:** The next match will be a Centerfire Shoot on May 14<sup>th</sup>. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three matches of the five matches during 2011. This is the third Centerfire Match for the 2011 Season. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles and pistols, at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. There will be a High Power Silhouette Match will be on April 24<sup>th</sup>. The next Small Bore Hunter Rifle and Pistol Cartridge Silhouette Match will be on May 1<sup>st</sup>. The next Varmint Hunter's Challenge and Benchrest Silhouette Match will be on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. The next Cowboy Lever Action Rifle and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match will be June 12<sup>th</sup>. Sign-in for matches (except Airgun) begins at 9:00 AM; shooting starts at 9:30 AM. ACTION PISTOL: There will be a USPSA Match on May 1<sup>st</sup>. The cost to shoot is \$15. Results of all shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. All Action Pistol shooters, including Juniors age 12 to 18, must complete the AP Orientation Course. There are openings for the May class on the 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup>. The fee for these classes is \$30, plus \$15 for the match. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup>. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. NO match or modified rifles are allowed. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match starts at 11:30 AM. This match is for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles are allowed. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may **not** use the same rifle in both the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost: \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

**IMPALEMENT ARTS:** There will be a Competition Fun Throw and Demonstration on May 29<sup>th</sup> starting at 10 AM. Lunch will be provided to participants. The "Impalement Arts" is the practice of chucking tools (knife and tomahawk throwing) at tree stumps (wood targets). Practices are held on Wednesdays and Thursdays at the Multi-Purpose range from about 3:00 PM until dark, and on weekends. There are throwing knives and tomahawks available as loaners if you are interested and don't have your own. If you would like to learn this craft, come down to the throwing range at 4:30 PM on Wednesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays. The range is now lit up so you don't have to toss tools in the dark. Books and videos are also available for members to learn more about the tool chuckin'. FFI: John Labash (709-9199).

**TRAP:** <u>A volunteer is needed to run the Trap events.</u> The Trap venue is defunct until we get a replacement. There are usually 3 or 4 Trap Shoots each year. Other members are available to help set up and run the shoots but a chairperson is needed. If you can take over the Trap Events Chair contact Scott or Dan. FFI - Dan Ashe (335-9193).

TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (& measure the length and girth) at any bait shop or store. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured at the clubhouse. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them in to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2011 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey (beard), Out-of-State Deer, Goose Wing, Salmon, Catfish, and Halibut. The winners for 2010 were: California Deer – Inland: Chris Falkenstein; Pheasant: Ed White; Turkey: Glenn Ashworth; Antelope: Phil DeShazo. Junior (16 and under) awards are given for all categories. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get 'em out to learn about the great outdoors. FFI call Randy Hammond ((510) 915-3644).

**AIR GUN FIELD TARGET:** The next match this year will be on May 15<sup>th</sup>, starting at 9 AM at the Action Pistol Range. Field Target shoots will be usually held on the third Sunday of each month. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles **and pistols** shooting at small game falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. The cost to shoot is \$5 and classifications include Pre-Charged, Spring-Piston, and possibly Offhand. A Fun Shoot will be held on May 29<sup>th</sup> and includes a Quigley Challenge's (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards). **YOUTH PROMOTIONS:** Youth shooters are the future of our sport. Children and Grandchildren of Diablo members, who are between the ages of 8 and 18, may participate in Youth Rifle & Pistol, and Shotgun activities. Rifle & Pistol use .22 cal. rimfire only and shoot at the Multi-Purpose Range. Ammunition is supplied at the rifle events. Some loaner rifles are available, but the shooters should provide their own firearms and parents should help out. During the shoots, a responsible adult, OTHER THAN the range officers, must supervise youth shooters. FFI – Ronald Savioni (228-4814). Shotgun events are at the Skeet Fields and shooters need their own shotguns. There will be a youth shotgun shooter orientation class on May 12<sup>th</sup> and the next shoot will be on May 15<sup>th</sup>. FFI – Rod Guyette (934-9455).
