AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The winners of the July Match were: Spring-Piston: Scott Rich; Pre-Charged: Bill Hooghuis; Youth: Donny Rich. There were 16 adult and 4 youth shooters at this competition. The next match will be on August 20th at the Action Pistol Range starting at 9:00 AM. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game silhouette targets. The next Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & Fun Shoot will be on October 8th at the Multi-Purpose Range, starting at 9:00 AM. The Fun Shoots use novelty targets. RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next shoot will be a Rimfire Shoot on August 12th. This is for .22 cal. long rifle, long, and short cartridges only. No magnum or other rimfire cartridges are permitted. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is **\$7.50** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. This is the fourth Rimfire Shoot. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$5 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The winner of the July Airgun Silhouette Match was: Greg Engle; Handicap Winner: Kelly Plummer. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on September 30th. The next Centerfire and Rimfire Benchrest Shoot will be on August 27th. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match is September 2nd. The July High Power Silhouette Match was canceled due to the extreme heat. The next High Power Silhouette Match is September 24th. Sign-in starts at 9:00 AM and shooting starts at 9:30 AM. ARCHERY: The USI Archery Range is opened when there are two persons shooting on the range and one is a qualified (by USI) Safety Officer. The cost is \$5 to shoot all day. Targets are set at 20, 40, and 60 yards, along with some 3D targets. Thursday evening Twilight shoots run from 5:00 PM until dusk for just \$2. SPORTING CLAYS: The next shoot will be an overnight trip on August 19th & 20th to Carson Valley on Saturday, followed by Sage Hill on Sunday. The cost is \$37 (approx) for Carson Valley and \$45 (approx) for Sage Hill. Lunch is included on both days. Prizes are awarded based on the Lewis Class system, and first place in each of the three classes plus the HOA. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand Match is September 23rd. Sign-in from 9 to 9:45 AM. Shooting starts at 10:00 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match between 12 & 12:45 PM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 1:00 PM. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms match. Each match requires 50 rounds plus sighters. Cost is \$10 each. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).
