AIR GUN: Next year's Airgun League will begin on January 14th. Shoots are held on the second and fourth Friday Nights each month from January through May. RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next match will be a Rimfire and Airgun Shoot on August 14th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three matches of the five matches during the year. This is the fourth Rimfire Match for the 2010 Season. INTERNATIONAL AIR PISTOL & RIFLE: There will be three International Air Pistol & Rifle Matches beginning this month and the next two months. These will be used as USA Shooting Preliminary Team Tryouts. Members of USA Shooting may submit their scores for a national ranking. Entry fees are \$10 with an additional \$5 to submit the scores. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles and pistols, at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on August 15th. The next Long Range Pistol and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match will be August 21st. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on August 22nd. ACTION PISTOL: There will be a USPSA Match on August 8th. The cost to shoot is \$15. Results of all shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. The next 3-Gun Match is on Saturday August 21st. There will be one more on the third Saturday of November. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. All Action Pistol shooters must complete the AP Orientation Course including Juniors, age 12 to 18. The September class is full. The next available class will be in November. SPORTING CLAYS: The next shoot will be on August 21st at Sage Hill in Reno (NV), followed by one at Coon Creek in Lincoln on the 22nd. Sign-in time will be 1:00 PM for both. AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The next match will be on August 15th. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. Fun Shoots include Quigley Challenge's (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards). M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, October 30th. Signin at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost: \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

IMPALEMENT ARTS: The "Impalement Arts" is the practice of chucking tools (knife and tomahawk throwing) at tree stumps (wood targets). A group gets together on Wednesdays and Thursdays at the Multi-Purpose range to practice from about 3:00 PM until dark, and on weekends. There are throwing knives and tomahawks available as loaners if you are interested and don't have your own. If you would like to learn this craft, come down to the throwing range at 4:30 PM on Wednesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays. There will be a Fun Day with demonstrations, a competition, and even free lunch on Saturday October 30th. Come find out what this activity is all about. TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (& measure the length and girth, especially for sturgeon) at any bait shop or store. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured at the clubhouse. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2010 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey (beard), Bear, Antelope, Sturgeon, and Striped Bass. Junior awards are given for all categories and are for kids 16 and under. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get the kids out there to learn about the great outdoors.
