SOCIAL DINNER: The December Social will be the Annual Christmas Dinner on Saturday, December 15th. AIR GUN: The 2008 Airgun League will begin on January 11, 2008. Shoots are held on the second and fourth Friday Nights each month from January through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so some shooting experience is required. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for shooters who don't have their own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: Field Target Shoots are over for the season (until it warms up and dries out). The 2007 Champions are: Pre-Charged Pneumatic: 1st: Pat Jacobs; 2nd: Frank Bobbio; 3rd: Greg Tobler; Spring-Piston: 1st: Scott Rich; 2nd: Kevin Yee; 3rd: GregTobler. This event uses "sporter-type" (high power) air rifles shooting at small game falling silhouette targets. The highest scores for the year were achieved by an old Spring-Piston over the "more sophisticated" pre-charged. This activity is for all shooters and Juniors shoot free. RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next shoot will be a Centerfire Match on January 12th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is \$7.50 per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: Watch the newsletter for the date of the next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost is \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).
