SOCIAL DINNER: The December Social will be the Annual Christmas Dinner on Saturday, December 13th. The club will provide the meat, rolls, salad, and drinks, and those attending should please bring a side dish to share with 8 to 10 other persons. There is a sign-up sheet posted in the clubhouse so that you can provide the names of children you'll be bringing who are 12 years old or younger. There will be a Barbeque Social on January 19th, and the Club will be providing the main meat dishes. AIR GUN: The 2009 Airgun League will begin on January 9, 2009. Shoots are held on the second and fourth Friday Nights each month from January through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so <u>some shooting experience is required</u>. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for shooters who don't have their own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. RIFLE AND PISTOL: The Match Season is over for this year. The Centerfire winners for the 2008 season will be posted on the web pages and will be in the next newsletter. The next match will be a Centerfire Match on Saturday, January 10th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. FFI call Dennis Winslow (510) 652-3319 or dmwinslow@aol.com.

RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles (and pistols) shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The November Air Rifle Silhouette Match winner was: John Labash; AA: Eric Ko; A: Joe Heckenbach; Varmint: Chris Heckenbach. The next Air Pistol Silhouette Match will be on December 21st. Sign-in starts at 2:00 PM. There next Benchrest Match will be on December 28th. There will be a Military Arms Benchrest Match on the same day, beginning at 10:30AM. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match is January 3rd. On January 4th there will be a Small Bore Cowboy Rifle Silhouette Match and a Hunter Pistol Silhouette Match. The November High Power Silhouette Match winner was John Labash; A: Dennis Winlsow. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on January 25th. A Pistol Cartridge Silhouette will follow that match. The next .22 Cal. Varmint Hunter's Challenge will be on February 22nd. Signin for the matches (except Airgun) begins at 9:00 AM and shooting starts at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles are allowed. FFI call John Labash (709-9199).

ACTION PISTOL: There were 56 shooters at the USPSA Match on November 9th. The next USPSA Match will be on December 14th and the cost to shoot is \$15. The results of the November Shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. All Match shooters must have completed the AP Orientation Course. Juniors, age 12 to 18, may now participate in Action Pistol Matches, but they must take the Orientation Course. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. Volunteers are always needed for stage designs and set-ups. The work parties that set up match stages for each shoot will be receiving certificates that are good for credit toward practice and match fees. The next Orientation Class with openings available will be on March 7th and 8th and the fee for these classes will be \$20, plus \$15 for the match. There are only 15 seats available for each class. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: Watch the newsletter for the winners of the November Matches. The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is scheduled for January 31st. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost is \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (and measure the length and girth) at any bait shop or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. The 2008 categories are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Jr. California Deer, Pheasant (tail), Jr. Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Jr. Trout (not steelhead), Turkey, Jr. Turkey, Out-of-State Deer, Duck Wing, Jr. Duck Wing, Steelhead, Jr. Steelhead, Black (Largemouth) Bass, and Jr. Black Bass. Junior categories are for kids 16 and under. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get the kids out there to learn about the great outdoors.
