AIR GUN: Next year's Airgun League will begin on January 14th. Shoots are held on the **second** and **fourth Friday Nights** each month from January through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so <u>some shooting</u> <u>experience is required</u>. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for shooters who don't have their own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. Sign-up starts at 6:30 PM and shooting starts at 7:00 PM. This is our 28th consecutive year. FFI: Pam Rogers (831-1037) or Ilene Falkenstein (687-5491).

RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next match will be a Centerfire Shoot on January 8th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least <u>three</u> matches of the five matches during 2011. INTERNATIONAL AIRGUN: International Air Pistol & Rifle Matches will be scheduled for next year. Members of USA Shooting may submit their scores for a national ranking. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles and pistols, at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The next Long Range Pistol and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match will be December 18th. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on December 19th. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on December 26th. ACTION PISTOL: There will be a USPSA Match on December 12^h. The cost to shoot is \$15. There will be a night shoot on December 18th starting at 5 PM. Results of all shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. All Action Pistol shooters must complete the AP Orientation Course including Juniors, age 12 to 18. The January class is full. The next available class will be February 12 & 13, 2011. The fee for these classes is \$30, plus \$15 for the match. AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: Field Target events are over for the year and will begin again in the Spring. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. Fun Shoots include Quigley Challenge's (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards). FISHING: <u>A new Fishing Chair is needed</u>. The events that Diablo usually holds are going to be cancelled due to the lack of a new Fishing Chair. If you can help out and take over, call Scott Belmore (709-0187).

M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, January 29th. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost: \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

IMPALEMENT ARTS: The "Impalement Arts" is the practice of chucking tools (knife and tomahawk throwing) at tree stumps (wood targets). A group gets together on Wednesdays and Thursdays at the Multi-Purpose range to practice from about 3:00 PM until dark, and on weekends. There are throwing knives and tomahawks available as loaners if you are interested and don't have your own. If you would like to learn this craft, come down to the throwing range at 4:30 PM on Wednesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays. The range is now lit up so you don't have to toss tools in the dark. Books and videos are also available for members to learn more about the tool chuckin'. FFI: John Labash (709-9199).

TRAP: <u>A volunteer is needed to run the Trap events.</u> Dan has been trying to run both Sporting Clays and Trap and the Trap venue is defunct until we get a replacement. There are usually 3 or 4 Trap Shoots each year. If you can take over for Dan there will be people to help you set up and run the shoots. When the new Trap Chair schedules the next Trap Shoot it will be in the newsletter. If you can take over the Trap Events Chair contact Scott or Dan. FFI - Dan Ashe (335-9193).

TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (& measure the length and girth, especially for sturgeon) at any bait shop or store. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured at the clubhouse. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2010 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey (beard), Bear, Antelope, Sturgeon, and Striped Bass. The last chance turn in your trophy from 2010 will be at the January 6th meeting. Junior awards are given for <u>all</u> categories and are for kids 16 and under. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get the kids out there to learn about the great outdoors. FFI call Randy Hammond ((510) 915-3644).

YOUTH PROMOTIONS: Youth shooters are the future of our sport. Children and Grandchildren of Diablo members, who are between the ages of 8 and 18 may participate in Youth Rifle & Pistol, and Shotgun activities. Rifle & Pistol use .22 cal. rimfire only and shoot at the Multi-Purpose Range. Ammunition is supplied at the rifle events.
