SOCIAL DINNER: The February social will be a Mexican Pot Luck on the third Tuesday of the month. Bring your favorite Mexican dish to share with 10 to 12 persons, and as always, your own plate and utensils. The dinner will have an Irish theme next month, so wear your green. AIR GUN: The 2007 Airgun League is underway. Shoots are held on the second and fourth Friday Nights each month through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so some shooting experience is required. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for those of you who don't have your own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least six matches. Sign-up starts at 6:30 PM and shooting starts at 7:00 PM. Joyce Langon has retired from the co-Chair position after many years of working on this shooting event. Many thanks for all you've done Joyce! Pam Rogers has stepped up. AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: There will be no more matches until next April or so. A Fun Shoot is scheduled for February 11th. Watch the newsletter for the schedule. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game silhouette targets. The matches use falling silhouette targets with a trip plate and the Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & Fun Shoots use novelty targets. Airguns have grown up; try it! RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next shoot will be a Rimfire Shoot on February 10th. This match is for .22 cal. short, long, or long rifle only. No magnums, no .17 cal., no other exotics. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is **\$7.50** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. FFI call Chuck Hunter (932-1772) or LaVerne Livsey (833-8778).

RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$5 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The Winner of the January Airgun Silhouette Match was John Labash. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on February 17th. Sign-in starts at 2:00 PM and shooting starts at 2:30 PM. The winners of the January Small Bore Silhouette Match were: Match Winner: Luis Bernardez; B Class: Byron Montague. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match is March 3rd. The January High Power Silhouette Match was canceled. The next High Power Match will be on March 25th. The next Benchrest Match is on February 25th. Sign-in for these matches starts at 9:00 AM and shooting starts at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles are allowed. FFI call John Labash (709-9199).

TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish at any bait shop (measure the length and girth) or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Note where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. The 2007 categories are: California Deer – Early Season, California Deer – Late Season, Jr. California Deer, Pheasant (tail), Jr. Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Jr. Trout (not steelhead), Antelope, Black Bear, Sturgeon, Jr. Sturgeon, Striped Bass, Jr. Striped Bass, Turkey, and Jr. Turkey. M1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is April 28th. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms match. Each match requires 50 rounds plus sighters. Cost is \$10 for one or \$15 for both. The winners of the January Match were: M1 Garand: 1st: Ezra Autajay; 2nd: Jaco Peeff; 3rd: John Peeff. NRA TRAINING: There will be a NRA Range Safety Officer training course on April 28th and again on May 26th. The class starts at 8 AM and ends at 5 PM both days. SPORTING CLAYS: The first shoot of the 2007 Season will be on April 21st at Birds Landing. Please arrive at least one hour prior to the posted start time. The cost will be \$47 and the targets will not be the "usual". Juniors shoot free. A \$10 deposit must be paid at least one week before the scheduled shoot date or there will be a \$10 late fee added to the listed cost of the shoot. Early sign-up is the only way you can be guaranteed a lunch at the shoot. Prizes at all shoots are awarded based on the Lewis Class system; first place through third, plus the HOA. There will be a Poker Run again and the winner determined at the Birds Landing shoot at the end of the year. The Red Bank/Thunder Hill shoots will be on May 19th. Make your room reservations ASAP because that is Chico State's graduation weekend.
