**AIR GUN:** This year's Airgun League is underway. Shoots are held on the **second** and **fourth Friday Nights** each month through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so <u>some shooting experience is required</u>. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for shooters who don't have their own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. Sign-up starts at 6:30 PM and shooting starts at 7:00 PM. This is our  $28^{th}$  consecutive year. FFI: Pam Rogers (831-1037) or Ilene Falkenstein (687-5491).

**DIABLO SOCIAL:** The next Social will be on Tuesday, February 15<sup>th</sup>. The Club provides finger foods, drinks (sodas, beer, wine, and spirits). **RIFLE AND PISTOL:** The next match will be a Rimfire Shoot on February 12<sup>th</sup>. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three matches of the five matches during 2011. This is the first Rimfire Match for the 2011 Season. **RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST:** Silhouette matches are for rifles and pistols, at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. There were No Results available from last month's matches. There will be a Cowboy Lever Action Rifle and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match will be February 13<sup>th</sup>. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on February 19<sup>th</sup>. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on February 27<sup>th</sup>. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match will be on March 5<sup>th</sup>. The next Small Bore Hunter Rifle and Pistol Cartridge Silhouette Match will be on March 6<sup>th</sup>. There will be a Varmint Hunter's Challenge and Benchrest Silhouette Match on March 27<sup>th</sup>. Sign-in for matches (except Airgun) begins at 9:00 AM; shooting starts at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles allowed except at .50 cal. Shoots. FFI: John Labash (709-9199).

**ACTION PISTOL:** There will be an USPSA Match on February 13<sup>th</sup>. The cost to shoot is \$15. Results of all shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. All Action Pistol shooters, including Juniors age 12 to 18, must complete the AP Orientation Course. The February class is full. There are only a few spots open for the March class on the 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup>. The fee for these classes is \$30, plus \$15 for the match. **FISHING:** A new Fishing Chair is needed. The events that Diablo usually holds are cancelled due to the lack of a new Fishing Chair. If you can help out and take over, call Scott Belmore (709-0187).

**TROPHY AWARDS:** Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (& measure the length and girth) at any bait shop or store. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured at the clubhouse. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them in to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2011 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey (beard), Out-of-State Deer, Goose Wing, Salmon, Catfish, and Halibut. The winners for 2010 will be announced at the March or April meeting. Junior awards are given for <u>all</u> categories and are for kids 16 and under. The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, April 30<sup>th</sup>. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. NO match or modified rifles are allowed. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles are allowed. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may **not** use the same rifle in both the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost: \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

**IMPALEMENT ARTS:** The "Impalement Arts" is the practice of chucking tools (knife and tomahawk throwing) at tree stumps (wood targets). A group gets together on Wednesdays and Thursdays at the Multi-Purpose range to practice from about 3:00 PM until dark, and on weekends. There are throwing knives and tomahawks available as loaners if you are interested and don't have your own. If you would like to learn this craft, come down to the throwing range at 4:30 PM on Wednesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays. **YOUTH PROMOTIONS:** Youth shooters are the future of our sport. Children and Grandchildren of Diablo members, who are between the ages of 8 and 18, may participate in Youth Rifle & Pistol, and Shotgun activities. Rifle & Pistol use .22 cal. rimfire only and shoot at the Multi-Purpose Range. Ammunition is supplied at the rifle events.
