SOCIAL DINNER: The Annual Crab Feed and Spaghetti Dinner will be held on January 20th starting at 6:30 PM. There are still some tickets available at \$25 per person and you must have a ticket in advance to attend the dinner. There will be an alternative dinner if you don't eat crab, but you must call Kathleen in advance. Call Kathleen White for tickets. The February social will be a Mexican Pot Luck. AIR GUN: The 2007 Airgun League will start up again on January 12, 2007. Shoots are held on the second and fourth Friday Nights each month from January through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so some shooting experience is required. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for those of you who don't have your own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: There will be no more matches until next April or so. A Fun Shoot is scheduled for February 11th. Watch the newsletter for the schedule. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game silhouette targets. The matches use falling silhouette targets with a trip plate and the Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & Fun Shoots use novelty targets. Airguns have grown up; try it! RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next shoot will be a Centerfire Shoot on January 13th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is **\$7.50** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$5 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The Winner of the December Airgun Silhouette Match was John Labash; 1st: Dennis Winslow; 2nd: 3rd: Eric Ko. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on January 20th. Sign-in starts at 2:00 PM and shooting starts at 2:30 PM. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on January 28th. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match is February 3rd. The winners of the December Benchrest Match were: Rimfire: John Labash; Varmint Challenge: Dee Carter. The next Benchrest Match is on April 29th. Sign-in starts at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles are allowed. FFI call John Labash (709-9199).

ACTION PISTOL: The next match will be on January 14th and the cost to shoot is \$15. ARCHERY: The USI Archery Range is opened when there are two persons shooting on the range and one is a qualified (by USI) Safety Officer. The cost is \$5 to shoot all day. Targets are set at 20, 40, and 60 yards, along with some 3D targets. The range will be in need of some repairs, so a work day is in the works. FFI call Greg Tobler (938-4782).

TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish at any bait shop (measure the length and girth) or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. The 2007 categories are: California Deer – Early Season, California Deer – Late Season, Jr. California Deer, Pheasant (tail), Jr. Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Jr. Trout (not steelhead), Antelope, Black Bear, Sturgeon, Jr. Sturgeon, Striped Bass, Jr. Striped Bass, Turkey, and Jr. Turkey. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is January 27th. Sign-in from 9 to 9:45 AM. Shooting starts at 10:00 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match between 12 & 12:45 PM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 1:00 PM. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms match. Each match requires 50 rounds plus sighters. Cost is \$10 each.
