AIR GUN: This year's Airgun League will begin on January 14th. Shoots are held on the **second and fourth Friday Nights** each month from January through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so some shooting experience is required. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for shooters who don't have their own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. Sign-up starts at 6:30 PM and shooting starts at 7:00 PM. This is our 28th consecutive year. FFI: Pam Rogers (831-1037) or Ilene Falkenstein (687-5491).

DIABLO SOCIAL: The next Social will be on Tuesday, January 18th. The Club provides finger foods, drinks (sodas, beer, wine, and spirits). RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next match will be a Rimfire Shoot on February 12th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three matches of the five matches during 2011. This is the first Rimfire Match for the 2011 Season. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles and pistols, at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The winner of the December Airgun Silhouette Match was John Labash. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on January 15th. There will be a Varmint Hunter's Challenge and Benchrest Silhouette Match on January 23rd. There will be an Airgun Fun Shoot on January 30th. The winners of the December Small Bore Silhouette Match were: HOA: John Labash; Varmint: Mike Elliot. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match will be on February 5th. The winner of the Low Power Rifle Match was John Labash, and the winner of the Cowboy Lever Action Rifle match was Dennis Winslow. The next Cowboy Lever Action Rifle and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match will be February 13th. The winners of the High Power Silhouette Match were: HOA: John Labash; A Steve Fenstriss; B: John Branch; Varmint: Bill McDaid. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on February 27th. The winners of the Small Bore Cowboy Rifle Silhouette Match were: HOA: John Labash; B: Gary Kolokovsis. The next Small Bore Hunter Rifle and Pistol Cartridge Silhouette Match will be on March 6th. Sign-in for matches (except Airgun) begins at 9:00 AM; shooting starts at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles allowed except at .50 cal. Shoots. FFI: John Labash (709-9199).

ACTION PISTOL: There will be an IDPA Match on January 23rd. The next USPSA match will be on February 13th. The cost to shoot is \$15. Results of all shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. All Action Pistol shooters, including Juniors age 12 to 18, must complete the AP Orientation Course. The January class is full. There are only a few spots open for the class on February 12th & 13th. The fee for these classes is \$30, plus \$15 for the match. Classes will be held monthly in 2011 and the schedule is posted on the Action Pistol web page. There will be a 3-Gun Match on February 27th. 3-Gun Matches will alternate with the IDPA Matches this year. FISHING: A new Fishing Chair is needed. The events that Diablo usually holds are going to be cancelled due to the lack of a new Fishing Chair. If you can help out and take over, call Scott Belmore (709-0187).

TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (& measure the length and girth, especially for sturgeon) at any bait shop or store. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured at the clubhouse. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2011 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey (beard), Out-of-State Deer, Goose Wing, Salmon, Catfish, and Halibut. The winners for 2010 will be announced at the March or April meeting. Junior awards are given for all categories and are for kids 16 and under. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get the kids out there to learn about the great outdoors. FFI call Randy Hammond ((510) 915-3644).

M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, January 29th. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost: \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

IMPALEMENT ARTS: The "Impalement Arts" is the practice of chucking tools (knife and tomahawk throwing) at tree stumps (wood targets). A group gets together on Wednesdays and Thursdays at the Multi-Purpose range to practice from about 3:00 PM until dark, and on weekends. There are throwing knives and tomahawks available as loaners if you are interested and don't have your own. If you would like to learn this craft, come down to the throwing range at 4:30 PM on Wednesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays. The range is now lit up so you don't have to toss tools in the dark. Books and videos are also available for members to learn more about the tool chuckin'. FFI: John Labash (709-9199).

INTERNATIONAL AIRGUN: International Air Pistol & Rifle Matches will be scheduled for next year. Members of USA Shooting may submit their scores for a national ranking. YOUTH PROMOTIONS: Youth shooters are the future of our sport. Children and Grandchildren of Diablo members, who are between the ages of 8 and 18 may participate in Youth Rifle & Pistol, and Shotgun activities. Rifle & Pistol use .22 cal. rimfire only and shoot at the Multi-Purpose Range. Ammunition is supplied at the rifle events. Some loaner rifles are available, but the shooters should provide their own firearms (with parental approval). FFI – Ronald Savioni (228-4814). AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: Field Target events are over for the year and will begin again in April. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. Fun Shoots include Quigley Challenge's (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards).
