**AIR GUN FIELD TARGET:** The next Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & Fun Shoot will be on July 15<sup>th</sup> at the Multi-Purpose Range, starting at 9:00 AM. The next match will be on July 16<sup>th</sup> at the Action Pistol Range starting at 9:00 AM. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game silhouette targets. The Fun Shoots use novelty targets. Airguns have grown up; try it! FFI call Greg Tobler (938-4782).

**RIFLE AND PISTOL:** The next shoot will be a Rimfire Shoot on August 12<sup>th</sup>. This is for .22 cal. long rifle, long, and short cartridges only. No magnum or other rimfire cartridges are permitted. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is **\$7.50** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. This is the fourth Rimfire Shoot. **RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST:** Silhouette matches are for rifles shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$5 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The next High Power Silhouette Match is July 23<sup>rd</sup>. The Small Bore Silhouette winners for July were: Match Winner: Greg Engle; AA: John Labash; A: Mike O'Brien; B: Ryan Franco; Varmint: Jeremi Jaujer (a Junior). The next Small Bore Silhouette Match is August 5<sup>th</sup>. The next Centerfire and Rimfire Benchrest Shoot will be on August 27<sup>th</sup>. Sign-in starts at 9:00 AM and shooting starts at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles are allowed. Airgun Silhouettes are in the works for Friday nights during the summer. **ACTION PISTOL:** The next Buckle Match will be on August 13<sup>th</sup> and the cost to shoot is \$10. **ARCHERY:** The USI Archery Range is opened when there are two persons shooting on the range and one is a qualified (by USI) Safety Officer. The cost is \$5 to shoot all day. Targets are set at 20, 40, and 60 yards, along with some 3D targets. Thursday evening Twilight shoots run from 5:00 PM until dusk for just \$2. If you call ahead Greg may have some loaner bows (in youth sizes) available. FFI call Greg Tobler (938-4782).

**SPORTING CLAYS:** The next shoot will be an overnight trip on August 19<sup>th</sup> & 20<sup>th</sup> to Carson Valley on Saturday, followed by Sage Hill on Sunday. The cost is \$37 (approx) for Carson Valley and \$45 (approx) for Sage Hill. Lunch is included on both days. Prizes are awarded based on the Lewis Class system, and first place in each of the three classes plus the HOA. The Poker Run is also underway with the winner determined at the end-of-the-year Birds Landing shoot. A \$10 deposit must be paid at least one week before the scheduled shoot date or there will be a \$5 late fee added to the listed cost of the shoot. Juniors shoot free, so come on out. **TRAP:** A Singles Trap Shoot is tentatively scheduled for July 29<sup>th</sup>. The cost will be \$20 for 100 targets shot from 16 yards. Sign-in and squad assignments will begin at 9:00 AM and shooters will be assigned to squads as they come in. Prizes will be awarded to the top three shooters in each class. **TROPHY AWARDS:** Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish at any bait shop (measure the length and girth) or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. The 2006 categories are: California Deer – Early Season, California Deer – Late Season, Jr. California Deer, Pheasant (tail), Jr. Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Jr. Trout (not steelhead), Elk, Duck Wing (from the elbow out), Halibut, Salmon, Black Bass, Jr. Black Bass, Turkey, and Jr. Turkey. **NRA TRAINING:** There will be a Basic Instructor Course and a Home Firearms Safety Instructor Course on July 22<sup>nd</sup> at a cost of \$100 each. The first class begins promptly at 8 AM in the Hunter Education building. A Chief Range Safety Officer Course will be held on July 23 at a cost of \$100. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand Match is September 23<sup>rd</sup>. Sign-in from 9 to 9:45 AM. Shooting starts at 10:00 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match between 12 & 12:45 PM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 1:00 PM. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms match. Each match requires 50 rounds plus sighters. Cost is \$10 each. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

**REMINDER:** <u>Safety</u> on the shooting ranges is <u>EVERYONE'S</u> responsibility. If you see someone doing something unsafe, say something to them. The Range Officers can't be everywhere and see everything, so help them out.
