AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The next match will be held on Sunday, June 15th. The matches use falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. The winners of the May Match were: Spring-Piston: Pat Jacobs; PCP: Kevin Yee. There were 10 shooters at that match. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game silhouette targets. The next fun shoot will be on June 29th at the Multi-Purpose Range. The Fun Shoots include a Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+Yards). RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next shoot will be a Rimfire Match on June 14th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. This is the third Rimfire Match for the 2008 Season. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles (and pistols) shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The May Air Rifle Silhouette Match winners were: John Labash; AA: Dennis Winlsow. The next Air Pistol Silhouette Match will be on June 21st. Sign-in starts at 2:00 PM. There will be a Benchrest Match will be on June 22nd. Varmint Hunter's Challenge will be July 13th. The winner of May's High Power Silhouette Match was Al Bolla. The next High Power Silhouette Match on July 27th. Sign-in at 9:00 AM and shoot at 9:30 AM. ACTION PISTOL: There were 53 shooters at the USPSA Match on May 18th. The next USPSA Match will be on July 13th and the cost to shoot is \$15. The USPSA-style Two-Gun Rimfire Match on May 25th had 11 shooters. The next Match will be an IDPA Match on June 22nd. The results of the May Shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. All Match shooters must have completed the AP Orientation Course. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. Volunteers are always needed for stage designs and set-ups. The work parties that set up match stages for each shoot will be receiving certificates that are good for credit toward practice and match fees. The next Orientation Class will be on July 12th and 13th and the fee for these classes will be \$20, plus \$15 for the match. There are only 15 seats available for each class. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is scheduled for August 30th. Signin at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost is \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

TRAP: The next shoot will be a Doubles Shoot on June 21st. The format will be "Report Pairs" where the second bird comes out as soon as the first bird is shot (at). There will be 25 pairs of trap targets and 25 pairs of wobble targets. There will also be some flash targets showing up. The cost will be \$25 and lunch will be available. This shoot will also be a fun shoot (no registered targets) and prizes will be based on Lewis Class. FFI Dan Ashe (335-9193).

TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (and measure the length and girth) at any bait shop or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. The 2008 categories are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Jr. California Deer, Pheasant (tail), Jr. Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Jr. Trout (not steelhead), Turkey, Jr. Turkey, Out-of-State Deer, Duck Wing, Jr. Duck Wing, Steelhead, Jr. Steelhead, Black (Largemouth) Bass, and Jr. Black Bass. Junior categories are for kids 16 and under. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get the kids out there to learn about the great outdoors. SPORTING CLAYS: The Sporting Clays Shoot schedule posted in the clubhouse and is on the web page. The next shoot will be June 22^{nd} at Rooster Ranch.
