RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next match will be a Rimfire Shoot on June 12th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three matches of the five matches during the year. This is the third Rimfire Match for the 2010 Season. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles and pistols, at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The next Long Range Pistol and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match will be June 13th. The winners of the May Air Rifle Match were: HOA: John Labash; AA: Ron Easton; B: Sun Lu. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on June 19th. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on June 27th. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match will be on July 3rd. There will be a Small Bore Hunter Rifle Silhouette Match and Pistol Cartridge Silhouette Match will be on July 4th. Sign-in for matches (except Airgun) begins at 9:00 AM; shooting starts at 9:30 AM. ACTION PISTOL: There will be a USPSA Match on June 13th. The cost to shoot is \$15. There were 49 shooters at the May USPSA Match and 43 at the IDPA Match. Results of all shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. The next 3-Gun Match is on Saturday August 21st. There will be one more on the third Saturday of November. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. All Action Pistol shooters must complete the AP Orientation Course including Juniors, age 12 to 18. The July class is full. The next available class is September 25th and 26th. The fee for these classes is \$30, plus \$15 for the match. This League will be on Wednesdays, beginning at 5 PM for 12 evenings through this summer. It is open to all members of USI Clubs and it is not required for shooters to complete the Orientation Course. The cost is \$5 per match and there are four divisions. There is no running, shooting is from the "Low, Ready" position, and no clock. There is a category for .22 Cal. as well. SPORTING CLAYS: There will be a shoot at Coyote Valley on June 26th starting at 10 AM. The cost for each shoot will range from \$25 to \$35 per 100 targets. **No reservations will be required and no lunches or refreshments will be provided.** The next shoot will be on July 16th at Walker River followed by one at Carson Valley on the 17th. AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The next match will be on June 20th. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. Fun Shoots include Quigley Challenge's (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards). M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The winners of the May M-1 Garand Match were: 1st: Dennis Winslow; 2nd: John Winslow; 3rd: Stephen Kinder, out of 3 shooters. The Military Arms Match was canceled due to a lack of shooters. The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, July 31st. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. IMPALEMENT ARTS: The "Impalement Arts" is the practice of chucking tools (knife and tomahawk throwing) at tree stumps (wood targets). A group gets together on Wednesdays and Thursdays at the Multi-Purpose range to practice from about 3:00 PM until dark, and on weekends. There are throwing knives and tomahawks available as loaners if you are interested and don't have your own. TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (& measure the length and girth, especially for sturgeon) at any bait shop or store. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured at the clubhouse. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2010 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey (beard), Bear, Antelope, Sturgeon, and Striped Bass. Junior awards are given for all categories and are for kids 16 and under. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get the kids out there to learn about the great outdoors.
