RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next match will be a Rimfire Shoot on June 11th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three matches of the five matches during 2011. This is the third Rimfire Match for the 2011 Season. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles and pistols, at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The next Cowboy Lever Action Rifle and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match will be June 12th. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on June 18th. ACTION PISTOL: The next USPSA Match is June 12th. There will be a 3-Gun Match on June 26th. The cost to shoot is \$15. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, July 30th. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. NO match/modified rifles allowed. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM. This match is for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only & NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles allowed. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may **not** use the same rifle in both the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost: \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

IMPALEMENT ARTS: The "Impalement Arts" is the practice of chucking tools (knife and tomahawk throwing) at tree stumps (wood targets). Practices are held on Wednesdays and Thursdays at the Multi-Purpose range from about 3:00 PM until dark, and on weekends. There are throwing knives and tomahawks available as loaners if you are interested and don't have your own. If you would like to learn this craft, come down to the throwing range at 4:30 PM on Wednesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays, and Sundays. Bullwhip snapping and boomerang tossing are now part of the activities. TRAP: <u>A volunteer is needed to run the Trap events.</u> The Trap venue is defunct until we get a replacement. There are usually 3 or 4 Trap Shoots each year. Other members are available to help set up and run the shoots but a chairperson is needed. If you can take over the Trap Events Chair contact Scott or Dan. FFI - Dan Ashe (335-9193).

TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (& measure the length and girth) at any bait shop or store. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured at the clubhouse. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them in to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2011 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey (beard), Out-of-State Deer, Goose Wing, Salmon, Catfish, and Halibut. Junior (16 and under) awards are given for <u>all categories</u>. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get 'em out to learn about the great outdoors. AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The next match this year will be on June 19th, starting at 9 AM at the Action Pistol Range. Field Target shoots will be usually held on the third Sunday of each month. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles **and pistols** shooting at small game falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. The cost to shoot is \$5 and classifications include Pre-Charged, Spring-Piston, and possibly Offhand. A Fun Shoot will be held on July 31st and includes a Quigley Challenge's (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards). YOUTH PROMOTIONS: Youth shooters are the future of our sport. Children and Grandchildren of Diablo members, who are between the ages of 8 and 18, may participate in Youth Rifle & Pistol, and Shotgun activities. Rifle & Pistol use .22 cal. rimfire only and shoot at the Multi-Purpose Range. Ammunition is supplied at the rifle events. Some loaner rifles are available, but the shooters should provide their own firearms and parents should help out. During the shoots, a responsible adult, OTHER THAN the range officers, must supervise youth shooters. FFI – Ronald Savioni (228-4814).

Shotgun events are at the Skeet Fields and shooters need their own shotguns. There will be a youth shotgun shooter orientation class on July 14^{th} and the next shoot will be on June 12^{th} . FFI – Rod Guyette (934-9455).
