DIABLO SOCIAL: The next Social will be on Tuesday, March 16th, starting at 5:30PM. The Club will provide a corn beef and cabbage dinner, finger foods, and drinks, including sodas, beer, wine, and spirits. Diablo members, family, and guests are invited to come by, grab a snack, a drink, and visit with other club members. FFI call Mark Hadox (813-2535).

AIR GUN: The 2010 Airgun League is underway. Shoots are held on the **second** and **fourth Friday Nights** each month from now through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so <u>some shooting experience is required</u>. The cost is \$2.50 per event. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are Club guns available for shooters who don't have their own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 (or with higher skill levels) shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. Sign-up starts at 6:30 PM and shooting starts at 7:00 PM. This is our 27th consecutive year. FFI: Pam Rogers (831-1037) or Ilene Falkenstein (687-5491).

RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next match will be a Centerfire Shoot on March 13th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three matches of the five matches during the year. This is the second Centerfire Match for the 2010 Season. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles and pistols, at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. There will be a 50 cal. BMG shoot on March 20th. The winner of the February Air Rifle Match was Eric Ko, and the Air Pistol Match winner was John Labash. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on March 21st. There will be a Benchrest Extravaganza on March 28th and a .22 Cal. Rimfire Varmint Hunter challenge the same day. The winners of the February Small Bore Silhouette Match were: HOA: John Labash; AAA: Al Bolla; AA: John Damiano; B: John Squadroni; Varmint: Kyle Muller. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match will be on April 3rd. The winner of the Cowboy Lever Action Match was Bill McDaid and the winner of the Low Power Rifle Match was John Labash. There will be a Small Bore Hunter Rifle Silhouette Match and Small Bore Hunter Pistol Silhouette Match will be on May 2nd. The winners of the High Power Rifle Silhouette Match were: HOA: John Labash; A: Dennis Christofani; B: Filipe Desouza; Varmint: Janet McDaid. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on April 25th. The next Long Range Pistol and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match will be June 13th. Sign-in for matches (except Airgun) begins at 9:00 AM; shooting starts at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles allowed except at .50 cal. Shoots. FFI: John Labash (709-9199).

ACTION PISTOL: There will be a USPSA Match on March 14th. There will also be an IDPA Match on March 28th. The cost to shoot is \$15. There were 58 shooters at the February USPSA Match and 24 at the 3-Gun Match. Results of those shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. There will be three more 3-Gun Matches this year on the third Saturday of May, August, and November. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. All Match shooters must complete the AP Orientation Course including Juniors, age 12 to 18. The next available class is May 22nd and 23rd. The fee for these classes is \$30, plus \$15 for the match. TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (& measure the length and girth, especially for sturgeon) at any bait shop or store. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured at the clubhouse. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2010 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey (beard), Bear, Antelope, Sturgeon, and Striped Bass. Junior awards will be given for all categories this year and are for kids 16 and under. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get the kids out there to learn about the great outdoors. IMPALEMENT ARTS: A new activity, currently called the "Impalement Arts" is up and running. It is the practice of chucking tools (knife and tomahawk throwing) at tree stumps (wood targets). A group gets together on Wednesdays and Thursdays at the Multi-Purpose range and practices from about 3:00 PM until dark and on weekends. There are throwing knives and tomahawks available as loaners if you are interested and don't have your own. FFI: John Labash (709-9199).

SPORTING CLAYS: There will be 14 shoots starting on April 10, 2010, at the Sun Mt. Gun Club in Coarse Gold, and followed on April 11th at Rooster Ranch in Los Banos. Sign-in times for each of these shoots will be 1:00 PM. The cost for each shoot will range from \$25 to \$35 per 100 targets. **No reservations will be required and no lunches or refreshments will be provided.** Prizes are awarded on the Lewis Class system for Club Members to HOA and three others. FISHING: A fishing day is planned for July 4th (Free Fishing Day) at San Pablo Reservoir. For the kids, tackle and bait will be provided, and there will be contests for all. The Oaks Campground/Picnic Area is reserved, and there will be horseshoes, volleyball, and other games available. The club will provide the picnic foods, drinks, etc., and this event is limited to the first 200 persons to sign up. Parking costs \$6.50. Planning is in progress for fishing trips next year, including one through the Redding Fly Shop for trout, and a deep sea charter trip. SKEET: There will be a Diablo Skeet Shoot on March 13th at 100 doubles targets. Sign-in starts at 9 AM and shooting will begin at about 9:30. The cost will be \$25. Lunch is available at the clubhouse but is not included in the shoot fees. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st through 3rd place winners. Sign-up in advance at the clubhouse, on the sheet posted on the bulletin board. The next shoot will be on May 22nd. FFI call Rod Guyette (934-9455).

TRAP: Dan is working on a schedule for 3 or 4 Trap Shoots this year, as he can fit them in. If you can help him set them up and run them let him know. Watch the newsletter for the next scheduled Trap Shoot. Dan is trying to run both Sporting Clays and Trap and the Trap venue could really use **a volunteer is needed to run the Trap events**. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, May 29th. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost: \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The next match will be in the Spring when the weather warms up. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. The Fun Shoots include a Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards).
