## **RANGE UPDATE**



#### Hello Diablo Members

Diablo wanted to give you an update on our range and what's been going on so far.

The old public range tear down has been completed. The new range design that was provided by our Architect Kramer One Inc. was sent out for initial bids which came back with estimates more than twice the amount that USI has available for this project, with several elements being of an unknown high risk (30' deep support castings).

Some initial decisions were made to try and reduce the costs of Kramer's design, changing to shorter range distances, reducing overhead size, tunnel shooting to eliminate the expensive baffles. But these had many additional concerns with noise, reduced usefulness, did not reduce the high risk problem, and still be above our budget.

Several members went to Shot Show to research other range design options and products that could benefit USI and save money. Additionally, members from several clubs were concerned with the reduced range distances proposed earlier and wanted every effort to be made to return to our original proposed range distances, one quote specifically stuck in my head "You don't zero your rifle to 95 yards!". So this design element has moved back to being a priority so as to best serve our collective members

We have been talking with two other range design company's, Paragon Tactical and AECOM (an original applicant for the range design), and hope to have a new design in the next few weeks.

There have been several meetings of the USI Board since then, to keep the project moving with Members from both Baypoint and Concord researching value engineering that would help with the overall costs of the range redevelopment. The committee identified several solutions that ranges use across the US, and are covered in detail in the NRA and URS range design guides. They were outlined as an updated scope and provided back to our architect.

USI requested Kramer One to make these changes, to use more affordable materials, to reduce the build cost to be more in line with our budget. Kramer One did not want to make those changes and sent a letter recommending that we obtain another architect.

## We will be reaching out and working with these entities and moving forward in our designs.

For those of you not able to attend the USI board meetings, here is a short summary of the recent motions and decisions.

• Bay Point made a motion to abandon the January 17th direction from the Board regarding making the pistol range 30' deep and the rifle range 95 yards deep. Concord seconded.

## Vote: Baypoint YES, Brentwood YES, Concord YES, Diablo YES, Walnut Creek NO.

• Bay Point made a motion to design the ranges as a 50' pistol range and a 100-yard rifle range. Brentwood seconded.

## Vote: Bay Point YES, Brentwood YES, Concord YES, Diablo YES, Walnut Creek NO. Motion passes.

- Concord made a motion to allow Construction Manager to contact Kramer to work with the new
- range solutions/elements and continue the range build. If Kramer decides to not do further work for us, the Construction Manager shall work with another architect to develop plans to replace Kramer One's designs with the specified elements brought forward by the committee. Paragon Tactical's architect is an alternative architect." Brentwood seconded this motion.

Vote: all agree, Motion passes.

# California Rifle & Pistol Association State Championship Match NRA Registered Tournament Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette – Rifle Cartridge Smallbore Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette Rifle Cowboy Lever Action Rifle – Pistol Cartridge

May 26, 27, 28; 2017

**Sponsored by:** California Rifle & Pistol Association (CRPA) **Hosted By:** Hat Creek Rifle & Pistol Club, Inc. of Burney, CA

Entry Deadline: Entries must be received by May 15, 2017 for Squading preparation. Late entries will be accepted up to ½ hour before the first relay. Assignment of relays will be on a "first come, first served basis". If you are shooting with a partner, please indicate that on your entry form. Entry Requirements: Proof of CRPA membership (or local state NRA affiliated state organization if non-resident) is required to shoot this match. Competitors may join the CRPA and/or NRA by contacting the Director or Statistics Official prior to the first relay.

<u>Course of Fire:</u> These matches will be fired in a squadded fashion as per NRA Rule 1.7(g). Target color will be orange. Competitors with color vision limitations who cannot see Hunter Orange targets may note that Vermillion colored glasses have been used to improve contrast.

**Thursday May 25, 2017:** The range will be available for sight-in and practice of all shooting events.

<u>Friday May 26, 2017 (Match #1, 2, 3</u>) will be Cowboy Lever Action - Rifle Cartridge. This championship will consist of two 40 round matches with an aggregate (Match #3) of 80 rounds for the championship. Match #1 will be called to the line at 8:00 am and Match #2 will commence after a short lunch break.

**Saturday May 27, 2017 (Match #4, 5, 6)** will be Cowboy Lever Action - Pistol Cartridge. This championship will consist of two 40 round matches with an aggregate (Match #6) of 80 rounds for the championship. Match #4 will be called to the line at 8:00 am and Match #5 will commence after a short lunch break.

## HCRP will provide a free BBQ Chicken dinner after the Saturday matches.

<u>Sunday May 28, 2017 (Match #7, 8, 9)</u> will be Cowboy Lever Action — Smallbore. This championship will consist of two 40 round matches with an aggregate (Match #9) of 80 rounds for the championship. Match #7 will be called to the line at 8:00 am and Match #8 will begin after a short lunch break.

<u>Classifications:</u> Any entry not possessing proof of classification or who is unclassified will compete in the highest class offered. After the first match the shooter will be reclassified. All competitors are required to have a 2015 NRA Silhouette Rifle Classification Book. These books will be available for purchase from the Statistical Officer (the current 2016 rate is \$13.00).

**Safety:** All NRA and Hat Creek Rifle & Pistol, Inc. Club rules will be strictly enforced. Failure to comply will cause disqualification. Eye and Ear Protection in the immediate area of the firing line is mandatory. Open Bolt Indicators are mandatory. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by competitors during the competition is not allowed.

**Equipment:** Equipment must conform to NRA Rule #3.1.3

<u>Ties:</u> Ties for each match will be broken by reverse animal count (commencing with the Ram count), except for match winner, which will be decided by a shoot off per NRA Rule 15.3(a).

**Match Officials and Jury:** The names of the match officials including a three-person jury, will be posted at the Championship site.

**Practice:** The range will be open for practice on Thursday May 25, 2017 from 9:00 am until dusk.


**Awards:** Awards for each 80 shot match will be given for all classes, Master through B for each match. Three Champions will be named, one for each day of matches. Special Class awards will be given to Super Senior and High Woman, (per NRA Rule 2.5), High Senior (per NRA Rule 2.2.1), High Junior (per NRA Rule 2.3-2.3.2). Super Senior, Senior, Woman, Junior, Intermediate Junior or Sub-Junior special classes must be declared in advance and may compete in only one such category. An aggregate winner (total of all three disciplines) will be named. There will be team awards for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. 5 and 10 in-a-row pins will be awarded, except for AAA and Masters will only receive 10 in-a-row pins. All special awards will be given to the competitors who earned them. Awards will be presented at the conclusion of each days matches.

**Teams for National Record:** Three member teams may be formed prior to the beginning of a match. The combined scores will be submitted to the NRA per Rule #17.5.

**Facilities:** Overnight camping is permitted at no charge. There is no charge for the practice day on Thursday. Campsites are unimproved. Bring your own food & water. No open campfires are permitted. Portable toilets and hand wash stations are available. Children must be under the supervision of an adult at all times. Pets must be on a leash. Motels are available in Burney and Fall River Mills. See information below.

AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: Held on the third Sunday of the month we shoot Air Rifle Field Target (and Air Pistol) at the Action Pistol Course at 09:00. We shoot "knock down" type targets at ranges from 10-55 yards. The matches follow standard AAFTA rules and classes. We foster a collegial type of shooting environment where one can learn and develop skills at their own pace. Airguns vary from inexpensive \$150 spring guns to full blown Anschutz match rifles. Airguns for this sport are limited to 20fpe of energy. Protective eye wear is required. Cost for the match is \$12.00 members and \$17.00 for Guests. Juniors cost \$7.00. per day.. AIR GUN: (Indoor) Shoots are held on the **second** and **fourth Friday nights** each month from January through May.
