**SOCIAL DINNER:** The October Social will be a Soup and Salad Pot Luck on Tuesday, October 17<sup>th</sup>. Please bring your favorite soup or salad to share with 10 to 12 other persons. If you would like to shoot some skeet before the social, be there at 5:00 PM, but you must stay for the social if you shoot. There will be no Social Dinner in November due to the normal Tuesday social date being so close to Thanksgiving. The annual Christmas Dinner will be held on December 16<sup>th</sup>. The club will provide the meat, salad, drinks, and bread. Bring a side dish to share with 10 to 12 persons. There will be a sign-up list for kids 12 and under for gifts from Santa. **AIR GUN:** The 2006 Airgun League is over for this year. The League will start up again in January of 2007. Shoots are held on the second and fourth Friday Nights each month from January through May. This will be our 23<sup>rd</sup> Season, so come out and give it a try. **AIR GUN FIELD TARGET:** The winners of the September Match were not available for the newsletter. There were 23 adult and 2 youth shooters at this competition (a new record turn-out!). There will be no more shoots until next Spring, so watch the newsletter for the schedule. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game silhouette targets. The matches use falling silhouette targets with a trip plate and the Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & Fun Shoots use novelty targets. Airguns have grown up; try it! **RIFLE AND PISTOL:** The next shoot will be a Centerfire Shoot on November 11th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is \$7.50 per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. This is the last shoot of the season. **RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST:** Silhouette matches are for rifles shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$5 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The Winners of the September Airgun Silhouette Match were: HOA: Greg Engel; A: Vien Nguyen; B: Byron Montague. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on October 21<sup>st</sup>. The next Benchrest Match is on October 29<sup>th</sup>. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match is November 4<sup>th</sup>. **ARCHERY:** The USI Archery Range is opened when there are two persons shooting on the range and one is a qualified (by USI) Safety Officer. The cost is \$5 to shoot all day. Targets are set at 20, 40, and 60 yards, along with some 3D targets. There will be a Swap Meet and Boo Shoot (at Halloween Targets) on October 29<sup>th</sup> at the Diablo Bowmen Archery Club. **SPORTING CLAYS:** Sporting Clays shoots are over for this year and will begin again in March of 2007. Prizes at these shoots are awarded based on the Lewis Class system, and first place in each of the three classes plus the HOA. Juniors shoot free. **TROPHY AWARDS:** Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish at any bait shop (measure the length and girth) or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. The 2006 categories are: California Deer – Early Season, California Deer – Late Season, Jr. California Deer, Pheasant (tail), Jr. Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Jr. Trout (not steelhead), Elk, Duck Wing (from the elbow out), Halibut, Salmon, Black Bass, Jr. Black Bass, Turkey, and Jr. Turkey. Junior categories are for kids 16 and under. Hunting Seasons are opening up and Fall fishing can result in some monsters. Sign-in from 9 to 9:45 AM. Shooting starts at 10:00 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match between 12 & 12:45 PM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting

starts at 1:00 PM. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms match. Each match requires 50 rounds plus sighters. Cost is \$10 each. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).
