DIABLO SOCIAL: The next Social will be on Tuesday, October 20th starting at 5:30PM and lasting until 9PM. AIR GUN: The indoor Airgun League is over for the year. The next season will begin again on January 8, 2010 for the 27th consecutive year. FFI: Pam Rogers (831-1037) or Ilene Falkenstein (687-5491).

AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The September match had 8 shooters plus 2 Juniors. Diablo shooters took two awards from the Arizona State Championships that same weekend. Congratulations to those winners. The next match will be on October 18th. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game, falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. There next Fun Shoot will be on November 29th and it will include a Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets: 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards). RIFLE AND PISTOL: There will be a Rimfire Shoot on October 10th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is \$6.00 per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles (and pistols), at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. There will be a Long Range Pistol and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match on October 11th. There will be an Air Pistol Silhouette Match on October 17th. The next Benchrest Match will be October 25th. There will be a .22 Cal. Rimfire Varmint Hunter challenge the same day. ACTION PISTOL: There will be a USPSA Match on October 11th. The cost to shoot is \$15. Results of the September Shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. There will be an IDPA Match on October 25th. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. All Match shooters must complete the AP Orientation Course including Juniors, age 12 to 18, who may now participate in Matches. The next class with openings will be on November 21st and 22nd. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, October 31st. Signin at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost is \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

Weigh fish (and measure the length and girth) at any bait shop or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2009 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey, Halibut, Catfish, Wild Pig, Goose Wing. Junior awards will be given for all categories this year and are for kids 16 and under. NOTICE: There are two proposed changes to the By Laws and Constitution of Diablo Rod and Gun Club that will be voted on at the next club meeting. The proposed changes are as follows:

1. To delete the requirement for new members to attend a meeting in order to receive their membership card by amending the Diablo Constitution Article 2 – Section 2(a) to read:

- "All applications for membership must be made in writing upon an application blank provided for this purpose, and must be accompanied by the appropriate dues and initiation fees. Applicants must be sponsored by a club member in good standing. Applicants are encouraged to attend a meeting to be considered for membership."
- 2. To eliminate the "half year" membership by amending the Diablo Constitution Article 2 Section 2(e) to read:
- "Membership periods available are lifetime, three year, and annual (July 1 to June 30 fiscal year). The lifetime membership is available only to a person who has been a member in good standing of Diablo Rod and Gun Club for a minimum of three years."

NOTICE: A bill prohibiting mail order sales of ammunition and components is on the Governor's desk. Contact him and urge him to VETO this infringement on our rights to keep and bear arms. That same bill also requires the collection of personal information for any sales of ammunition. Call the Governor's office and urge him to VETO this bill. Whether your elected representatives reflect your opinions or not, call them so they'll know that there is another viewpoint out there and that you vote! Check the website for more details.
