Progress Report Rifle/Pistol Range

On September 13, 2016 we submitted the application materials and plans to Contra Costa County Department of Conservation and Development for a compliance review of our plans to remodel the Rifle/Pistol Range. The County notified us on October 6, 2016 that our plans are in compliance with the Conditions of Approval set forth in County File #13-2076."

Now that we have planning clearance for the project and California Environmental Quality Act compliance, our next step is to start the building permit application which we hope to submit at the end of this week, October 14, 2016, or the beginning of next week.



AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: Held on the third Sunday of the month we shoot Air Rifle Field Target (and Air Pistol) at the Action Pistol Course at 09:00. We shoot "knock down" type targets at ranges from 10-55 yards. The matches follow standard AAFTA rules and classes. We foster a collegial type of shooting environment where one can learn and develop skills at their own pace. Airguns vary from inexpensive \$150 spring guns to full blown Anschutz match rifles.
