SOCIAL DINNER: The September Social will be an Oriental Pot Luck on Tuesday, September 19th. Please bring your favorite Oriental dish to share with 10 to 12 other persons. If you would like to shoot some skeet before the social, be there at 5:00 PM, but you must stay for the social if you shoot. The October Social will be on Tuesday, October 17th and will be a Soup and Salad Pot Luck, so you are asked to bring your favorite soup or salad to share with 10 to 12 other persons. AIR GUN: The 2006 Airgun League is over for this year. The League will start up again in January of 2007. Shoots are held on the second and fourth Friday Nights each month from January through May. AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The winners of the August Match were: Spring-Piston: Scott Rich; Pre-Charged: Greg Tobler; Youth: Donny Rich. There were 12 adult and 2 youth shooters at this competition. The next match will be on September 17th at the Action Pistol Range starting at 9:00 AM. There will also be a Swap Meet at this shoot so bring the equipment that you're not using and trade it for something that you want to use. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game silhouette targets. The next Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & Fun Shoot will be on October 8th at the Multi-Purpose Range, starting at 9:00 AM. The Fun Shoots use novelty targets. RIFLE AND PISTOL: The next shoot will be a Rimfire Shoot on October 14th. This is for .22 cal. long rifle, long, and short cartridges only. No magnum or other rimfire cartridges are permitted. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is **\$7.50** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. This is the last Rimfire Shoot of the 2006 season. RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$5 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The next High Power Silhouette Match is September 24th. The next Airgun Silhouette Match will be on September 30th. ARCHERY: The USI Archery Range is opened when there are two persons shooting on the range and one is a qualified (by USI) Safety Officer. The cost is \$5 to shoot all day. Targets are set at 20, 40, and 60 yards, along with some 3D targets. Thursday evening Twilight shoots run from 5:00 PM until dusk for just \$2. If you call ahead Greg may have some loaner bows (in youth sizes) available. There will be a "Discovery Archery" shoot at the Diablo Bowmen Archery Club on October 8th. There will be some basic instruction, loaner equipment, and a "Diablo Dog" lunch available for \$6. There will also be a Swap Meet and Boo Shoot (at Halloween Targets) on October 29th. TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish at any bait shop (measure the length and girth) or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. The 2006 categories are: California Deer – Early Season, California Deer – Late Season, Jr. California Deer, Pheasant (tail), Jr. Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Jr. Trout (not steelhead), Elk, Duck Wing (from the elbow out), Halibut, Salmon, Black Bass, Jr. Black Bass, Turkey, and Jr. Turkey. Junior categories

M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand Match is September 23rd. Sign-in from 9 to 9:45 AM. Shooting starts at 10:00 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match between 12 & 12:45 PM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 1:00 PM. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms match. Each match requires 50 rounds plus sighters. Cost is \$10 each. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

REMINDER: <u>Safety</u> on the shooting ranges is <u>EVERYONE'S</u> responsibility. If you see someone doing something unsafe, say something to them. The Range Officers can't be everywhere and see everything, so help them out.
