**SOCIAL DINNER:** There will be no social dinner in September. The next social dinner will be on October 21<sup>st</sup> and will be an Italian theme. The dinner will begin at 6:30 PM. The club will provide different kinds of pasta dishes and those attending are asked to bring a side dish to share with 4 to 6 other persons. There may be skeet shooting before dinner if someone volunteers to run the field. If you would like to shoot some skeet before that social, be there at 5:00 PM, but you must stay for the social if you shoot. FFI call Rose Henry (510 860-3913).

**AIR GUN FIELD TARGET:** The next match will be held on Sunday, September 21<sup>st</sup>. The matches use falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game silhouette targets. The next fun shoot will be on November 30<sup>th</sup> at the Multi-Purpose Range. The Fun Shoots include a Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards). Airguns have grown up; try it! FFI call Greg Tobler (938-4782).

**RIFLE AND PISTOL:** The September shoot will be a Centerfire Match on Saturday, September 13<sup>th</sup>. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and you must have your firearms already sighted in. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds standing and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three of the five matches during the season. This is the fourth Centerfire Match for the 2008 Season. **RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST:** Silhouette matches are for rifles (and pistols) shooting at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The August Air Pistol Silhouette Match winners were: HOA: Paul Alexander; AAA Dennis Winslow; B: Mike Elliot. The next Air Rifle Silhouette Match will be on September 20<sup>th</sup>. Sign-in starts at 2:00 PM. The next .22 Cal. Varmint Hunter's Challenge will be September 21<sup>st</sup>. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be on September 28<sup>th</sup>. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match is October 4<sup>th</sup>. There will be a Lever-Action and Hunting Pistol Silhouette Match in the afternoon after the Small Bore Match. The winners of the August Benchrest Match were: Rimfire: John Labash; Centerfire: John Branch; There next Benchrest Match will be on October 26<sup>th</sup>. Sign-in for the matches (except Airgun) begins at 9:00 AM and shoot at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles are allowed. The State Air Pistol Silhouette Championships will be held on September 27 & 28 at the Modesto Rifle Club. Diablo will be there! FFI call John Labash (709-9199).

**ACTION PISTOL:** There were 45 shooters at the USPSA Match on August 10<sup>th</sup>. The next USPSA Match will be on September 14<sup>th</sup> and the cost to shoot is \$15. The next IDPA Match will be on September 28<sup>th</sup>. The results of the August Shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. All Match shooters must have completed the AP Orientation Course. Juniors, age 12 to 18, may now participate in Action Pistol Matches, but they must take the Orientation Course. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. Volunteers are always needed for stage designs and set-ups. The work parties that set up match stages for each shoot will be receiving certificates that are good for credit toward practice and match fees. The next Orientation Class with openings available will be on November 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> and the fee for these classes will be \$20, plus \$15 for the match. **M1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE:** The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is scheduled for November 29<sup>th</sup>. Sign-in at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost is \$10 for one or \$15 for both. The winners of the August Match were: M1 Garand: 1<sup>st</sup>: Ezra Autajay; 2<sup>nd</sup>: Robert Frost; 3<sup>rd</sup>: John Peef; Military: 1<sup>st</sup>: Ezra Autajay; 2<sup>nd</sup>: Larry Lucas; 3<sup>rd</sup>: Dennis Early. **TRAP:** The next shoot will be on September 28<sup>th</sup> starting at 1PM. The format will involve some trap targets, some wobble targets and some doubles. There will be some flash targets thrown in and as always, it will be a fun shoot (no registered targets). Prizes will be based on Lewis Class. The cost will be \$25 for 250 targets and lunch will be provided. On the third Friday of September and October there will be a Flurry Shoot (add'l information is in the clubhouse). This game involves teams of two shooters attempting to break as many clay targets as fast as they are launched. Accuracy and the ability to reload quickly are necessary skills for this type of shooting, and its all for fun. FFI Dan Ashe (335-9193).

**TROPHY AWARDS:** Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (and measure the length and girth) at any bait shop or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. The 2008 categories are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Jr. California Deer, Pheasant (tail), Jr. Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Jr. Trout (not steelhead), Turkey, Jr. Turkey, Out-of-State Deer, Duck Wing, Jr. Duck Wing, Steelhead, Jr. Steelhead, Black (Largemouth) Bass, and Jr. Black Bass. Junior categories are for kids 16 and under. Juniors are the future of all outdoor sporting activities, so get the kids out there to learn about the great outdoors. **SPORTING CLAYS:** The Sporting Clays Shoot schedule is posted in the clubhouse and is on the web page. The next shoot will be October 4<sup>th</sup> at Birds Landing. Sign-in 10 AM. Please arrive at least one hour prior to the sign-in time. The cost will be \$49 and lunch will be provided. Mail your deposit to Bob Loo, whose address is on the web site and posted with the schedule in the clubhouse. Early sign-up is the only way you can be guaranteed a lunch at the shoot.
