DIABLO SOCIAL: The next Social will be on Tuesday, September 15th starting at 5:30PM and lasting until 9PM. The Club will provide all of the food and drinks, which include fine sodas, beer, wine, and spirits. AIR GUN: The indoor Airgun League is over for the year. The next season will begin again on January 8, 2010 for the 27th consecutive year. FFI: Pam Rogers (831-1037) or Ilene Falkenstein (687-5491).

AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: The next match will be on September 20th. This outdoor event uses "sporter-type" air rifles shooting at small game, falling silhouette targets with a trip plate. There next Fun Shoot will be on November 29th and it will include a Quigley Challenge (long range off-hand event) & "Air Sniper" targets: 10 shots, any position, no supports, paper bulls, no sighters once you begin, (60+ Yards). Airguns have "grown up"; try it! FFI call Greg Tobler (938-4782).

RIFLE AND PISTOL: There will be a Centerfire Shoot on Sept. 12th. You need 30 rounds for a match. Shooting is by squads and firearms must be sighted in already. The cost is **\$6.00** per event. The events are scoped rifle, scoped pistol, iron sight rifle, and iron sight pistol. Shooting is done from 3 positions with a minimum of 10 rounds offhand (standing) and a maximum of 10 rounds prone. To be eligible for awards at the end of the year you must shoot in at least three matches. This is the fourth Centerfire Shoot. FFI call Dennis Winslow (510) 652-3319 or dmwinslow@aol.com.

RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE/BENCHREST: Silhouette matches are for rifles (and pistols), at silhouette targets, Offhand or Varmint Class, (no slings or jackets). It costs \$6 and you need 60 rounds for a match. The winner of the August Air Pistol Silhouette Match was Don Buenting. The next Air Rifle Silhouette Match will be September 19th. The next High Power Silhouette Match will be September 27th. A Pistol Cartridge Silhouette Match will follow; sign-in starts at 1:00 PM. The next Small Bore Silhouette Match is October 3rd. There will be a Long Range Pistol and Low Power Rifle Silhouette Match on October 11th. The winners of the August Benchrest Match were: Air Rifle: John Labash; Rimfire: Jim Kantski; Centerfire: Joe Heckenbach. The next Benchrest Match will be October 25th. There will be a .22 Cal. Rimfire Varmint Hunter challenge the same day. The next Small Bore Cowboy Rifle Silhouette Match and Small Bore Hunter Pistol Silhouette Match will be November 1st. Sign-in for matches (except Airgun) begins at 9:00 AM; shooting starts at 9:30 AM. No .50 cal. rifles allowed. FFI: John Labash (709-9199).

ACTION PISTOL: There will be an USPSA Buckle Match on September 13th, followed by the Annual Barbeque. The cost to shoot is \$15. Results of the August Shoots are posted on the Action Pistol web page. There will be an IDPA Match on September 27th. All Match shooters must complete the AP Orientation Course including Juniors, age 12 to 18, who may now participate in Matches. Sign-in for all matches begins at 8 AM and closes at 8:30 AM. The next class with openings will be on November 21st and 22nd. The September class is full. The fee for these classes will be \$30, plus \$15 for the match. M 1 GARAND & MILITARY RIFLE: The next M-1 Garand/Military Arms Match is on Saturday, October 31st. Signin at 9 AM. Shooting starts at 9:30 AM. Format is a modified DCM at 200-yard targets; iron sights only. No match or modified rifles. Sign-in for the Military Arms Match at 11:30 AM for foreign, domestic, bolt, or semi-auto rifles (including M1A standard & pre-ban AR-15) shooting at 100-yard targets. Iron sight rifles only and NO match, modified, or 50 cal. BMG rifles. Shooting starts at 12:00 Noon. You may not use the same rifle in the Garand Match and Military Arms Match. Each match requires 50 rounds. Cost is \$10 for one or \$15 for both. FFI call Greg Ong (706-7811).

FISHING: There will be a Deep Sea Fishing Trip on October 4th, on the El Dorado III out of the Berkeley Marina. The boat will leave at 6:00 AM. There is room for 25 adults; guests and kids may sign up as seats allow. The cost is \$60 each, and the Club will provide the food and drink. TROPHY AWARDS: Jackets are awarded to those who catch the biggest fish and bag the biggest critters. Weigh fish (and measure the length and girth) at any bait shop or store, and have critters measured at the clubhouse. Make a note of where the fish was measured, with the phone number and name of a witness for verification, along with a picture. Contact Randy to get the birds and antlers measured. Always take pictures of you and your critter and bring them to share with the other hunters and fishermen (& women). The categories for 2009 are: California Deer – Coastal Season, California Deer – Inland (Late) Season, Pheasant (tail), Trout (not steelhead), Turkey, Halibut, Catfish, Wild Pig, Goose Wing. Junior awards will be given for all categories this year and are for kids 16 and under. TRAP: The next Trap Shoot will be on September 19th. It will begin at about 1:00 PM after sign-ups. The course of fire will be 100 targets from 16yds, (straight Trap Targets). The cost will be \$25 and lunch will be available in the clubhouse (but not provided). FFI Dan Ashe (335-9193).

NOTICE: There will be some discussion about potential changes to the By Laws and Constitution of the Club at the next meeting. The primary topics will be the elimination of the half-year memberships and eliminating the requirement for applicants for membership to attend a meeting to obtain their membership cards.
