Air Gun Silhouettes Moves to the Action Pistol Range from the MPR

With the success of the '22's on the MPR', Diablo decided to open the air gun silhouettes on the Action Pistol Range. As you know, the MPR is open to 22's from 10 - 6 on Saturdays and Sundays.

So, the next Diablo Silhouette Match is this Sunday October 1st at 1pm on the A/P Range

Our monthly Diablo Rod and Gun Club Air Gun Silhouette match will continue on the 1st Sunday at 1:00 PM in Concord. This will just be a continuation of the excellent matches that Pat Radler sponsored on the MPR. We have been shooting the event on the stands constructed by Mike Aber. Before that, we shot animals on 4x4 rails under John LaBash'es direction.

Come out and enjoy some Silhouette shooting. It is a simple sport. You knock down the animals and then pull them back up using a string attached to the target stand. There is a Varmint class which just means shooting off the bench or do the usual standing. Pat Radler has created a number of fun contests to take in to account the different types of air guns which might be used

Here is additional information from Pat's standing email.

The 40 shot rifle match is 10 shots each at 1/10th scale chickens, pigs, turkeys and rams at 20,30,36 and 45 yards. We shoot two banks of 5 animals per Relay.

Air pistol and Short-Range Air Rifle (SAR) is shot at 10, 12.5, 15 and 18 yards for chickens, pigs, turkeys and rams respectively.

There are three classes of NRA Air Rifle Silhouette: Open (all PCPS), Target (unaltered factory 10 meter guns) and Sporter (any unaltered OTC factory non PCP including springer and 12g CO2.

Two classes of NRA Air Pistol Silhouette: Standing and Open Sight Standing.

Three classes of IHMSA Air Pistol Silhouette: Standing, Unlimited Standing and Unlimited Standing Iron Sight.

We also have four of our own DR&GC Air gun games for fun: Short-Range Air Rifle (SAR) on pistol targets (under 12 ft. lbs.), Long-Range Air Pistol (LAP) on rifle targets, Varmint Air Rifle (off the bench) and Varmint Air Pistol. All guns must be below 20 fpe for rifle and 12 fpe for pistol to prevent target damage.

Even beginners will find a class that suits their ability and will knock down enough animals to feel a sense of accomplishment and fun. We have a great group of folks participating at all levels. Our more experienced shooters are always ready to help new shooters develop their skills. You don't need an expensive rifle or pistol to join in the fun. Bring what you have and give it a try.

Rifles are limited to 20 fpe or less and Pistols are 12 fpe or less. Calibers permitted are .177, .20 and .22 only. No .25 caliber. Lead pellets only. No BBs, darts or plastic tipped or metal coated pellets. All spectators and shooters are required to wear safety glasses. Hearing protection is optional and recommended.

Cost is \$10.00 for members and \$15.00 for Guests. Shooters under the age of 18 accompanied by an adult shoot free

We typically run two Relays so you can shoot rifle in one relay and pistol or other rifle or pistol class in another. You can even shoot a refire, which is a second round of the same class. Our targets are custom built, one-of-a-kind string resettable silhouettes so the matches tend to go pretty quickly

Have fun and keep your rifle and pistol shooting skills sharp with air gun silhouette. Hope to see you there for a great day of shooting.

Ladies and juniors are encouraged to attend to see and experience what the excitement is all about.

There will be free air tank refills from the club compressor after the match for tanks with a current hydro.

All shooters must sign the USI liability waiver form located on line here prior to shooting a match at USI: http://unitedsportsmen.com/waiver/ It is free, signed on line and is a one time procedure. After signing the waiver, all shooters are required to obtain a USI "Blue Card" available free at the club house. You must have your Blue card with you. USI is now charging a \$5.00 replacement fee. I suggest you take a picture of it and store it in your mobile device.



ACTION SHOOTING: Shooting at Richmond. Check time with chairman

AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: Held on the third Sunday of the month we shoot Air Rifle Field Target (and Air Pistol) at the Action Pistol Course at 09:00. We shoot "knock down" type targets at ranges from 10-55 yards. The matches follow standard AAFTA rules and classes. We foster a collegial type of shooting environment where one can learn and develop skills at their own pace. Airguns vary from inexpensive \$150 spring guns to full blown Anschutz match rifles. Airguns for this sport are limited to 20fpe of energy. Protective eye wear is required. Cost for the match is \$12.00 members and \$17.00 for Guests. Juniors cost \$7.00. per day.. AIR GUN: (Indoor) Shoots are held on the **second** and **fourth Friday nights** each month from January through May. All shooting is done offhand (standing) at paper targets so <u>some shooting experience is required</u>. All shoots are held in the clubhouse and there are club guns available for shooters who don't have their own. Juniors (ages 8 to 18) shoot free, but those over 16 shoot in the adult classifications. Competition is by classification (shooting against other shooters in your class) except for the high overall scores. Everyone who shoots at least six matches has a chance to win something. Initiation Fee is \$5.00 and \$2.50 for each match. Sign-up starts at 6:30 PM and shooting starts at 7:00 PM. FFI Ken Rogers: 925-831-1037.

AIRGUN SILHOUETTE: Matches are for air rifles and pistols, shooting is at the METALLIC chickens, pigs, turkeys and rams. Matches cost is \$14.00 for members and \$21.00 for Guests.
