International Matches by Rodolfo Soncuya



International matches we shoot at the Diablo Club are replicas of the program they shoot in the Olympics and in the World Cup. We follow the International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF) rules. All matches are registered, sanctioned with USA Shooting or with NRA. We shoot this during the summer time at the multipurpose range. Scores are sent in to USA Shooting for national ranking. Cost is ten dollars per match juniors shoot free.

International Air Pistol:

Standing one hand 60 shots; women, 40 shots. B40/4 targets (10 meters). Three shots per bull. Fired as a 17 ½ minute sighter period, then five series of 12 shots in 17 ½ minutes, for record score. All sighter shots are fired before the first record shot.

International Air Rifle:

Standing, 60 shots; women, 40 shots AR5/10 targets (10 meters). One shot per bull. Five series of twelve shoots in $17 \frac{1}{2}$ minutes for record. A sighter series will be fired before the first record shots.

International Free Pistol

Open, 60 shots. B 19 targets (50 yards). Total time for 60 shots including unlimited sighters is 2 hours. Ten shots per bull. Fired as a 17 minute sighter period, then six series of 10 shots in 17 minutes. All sighter shots are fired before the first record shot.

Standard Pistol

Standing, 60 record shots, B19 targets at 25 yards. Ten shots per target. A five shots 150 second sighter series will be fired. Four series of five shots in 150 seconds ($2\frac{1}{2}$

minutes) four series of five shots in 20 seconds and four series of five shots in 10 seconds

Center Fire & Women Sport

Standing, 60 record shots, B19, B38 targets at 25 yards. A five shot sighter series will be fired before each stage. Precision stage: six series of five shots in five minutes, ten shots per target. Rapid fire stage: six series of five shots, during each series the target appears five times for three seconds and a seven seconds pause between each appearance. One shot will be fired during each three second appearance.

Hi Pwr Silhouettes Match on Sunday Aug 23rd. Report

It was a beautiful day on the MPR. Everyone helped with the setup as most of the attendees have participated before. A safety presentation was held and questions answered. This is always a good time to spread the word on what is happening around Diablo and USI.

We like to think of the Hi Pwr contest as the king of the silhouettes. It seems to be the most difficult. That's interesting as the real contest is actually much harder. It is shot out to 500 meters with pigs at 300, turkeys at 400 and rams at 500. Our animals are reduced (like a 2/5s ram) to make them correct for 200 meters. Any centerfire rifle will knock the animals down at 200 meters, but the real contest at 500 requires lots of bullet at a good velocity. Most popular are the 6.5s w/ 140gr slugs. The 308 is probably the most used due to availability.

Results were: Offhand Class: Kevin Newton - match winner. Chaz shot an 8 to win B class. On the varmint class (benched with a front rest) Jeff Atchison shot a 40/40 for 1st place. Roger Umbdenstock was second with a 39. Richard Burkett was 3rd with 38.

AIR GUN FIELD TARGET: Held on the third Sunday of the month we shoot Air Rifle Field Target (and Air Pistol) at the Action Pistol Course at 09:00. We shoot "knock down" type targets at ranges from 10-55 yards. The matches follow standard AAFTA rules and classes. We foster a collegial type of shooting environment where one can learn and develop skills at their own pace. Airguns vary from inexpensive \$150 spring guns to full blown Anschutz match rifles. Airguns for this sport are limited to 20fpe of energy. Protective eye wear is required. Cost for the match is \$5.00 per day, juniors shoot free. We usually have a POTLUCK BBQ with grilled hotdogs or mild link sausages for lunch. At the conclusion of the FT match we host an open shooting session or pistol match. AIRGUN, RIMFIRE & CENTERFIRE METALLIC SILHOUETTE: SILHOUETTES: 6 events. Matches are for rifles and pistols, shooting is at the METALLIC chickens, pigs, turkeys and rams. Matches cost \$7. It is an offhand game but shooters are welcome to shoot off the bench in VARMINT CLASS. SMALL BORE Silhouettes (1st Saturday 8:30am) consists of 3 banks of 5 shots each on the 4 animals for a total of 60 rounds. All the other events are 2 banks on each animal for 40 shoots. HIGH POWER Silhouettes is at 200yds (4th Sunday at 8:30am on even months). AIRGUN Silhouettes (1st Sunday at 1pm). There are 3 Cowboy Lever Action Silhouette (CLA) events for open sights. 1: CLA for 30/30s etc (4th Saturday at 8:30am odd months). 2: PISTOL CARTRIDGE CLA for .357s etc which alternates even months (3rd Saturday or Sunday at 1pm) against 3:SMALL BORE CLA in the odd months. 
